## Title: Page 206 of the Kinney Day Book Provenance: This is an original journal, handwritten by Nathan Johnson Kinney, now in my possession.

This Day Book aka Journal, written by Nathan Kinney, is where he copied every receipt, letter, thoughts, inventories, and even family tree diagrams he had drawn by hand. He was a teacher, so he made entries according to the parent's name and numbered each student he ever taught. It covers his time living in Belmont County, Ohio and later in life, he lived near a little town of Etna, Ohio and is buried there.

There are several of these hand drawn graphic family trees, with different families, throughout the journal.

This Family Tree was drawn by Nathan Kinney (1830-1896) [grandson to Thomas and Margaret]. It stretches across two legal size pages in his Day Book. Very intricate, I am going to "try" to get it all written down and linked to main Kinney family members listed on the branches. On the TRUNK of the tree, are the main characters: THOMAS KIN-NEY [AFN: LZ73-ZRB] AND WIFE, MARGARET CARR. Each main branch off the trunk of the tree has the name of one of their children.

\*\*1. Beginning at the bottom of the tree trunk, on page 207, on the left side, the first branch contains the name of a son, WILLIAM KINNEY [AFN LZ8G-VVQ] who married Jane Goff. William had twelve children, so there are MANY branches attached to this parental branch, for each of them..

\*\*2. Following along the left side of the tree, the next main branch off of the trunk, on page 206, contains the name of the son, THOMAS KINNEY [AFN: LHC7-T5X] who married Alice Pearson. They had 7 or 8 children. \*\*\*2a. CHILDREN: Along the branches connected to Thomas and Alice:

a. ANDREW KINNEY [L4MM-W3W] showing his wife, Susan Hart, and their children: Estep, John, Cephas, Jenkins, Frank, David Caswell and Hudson.

a. MARGARET KINNEY [LHV4-193] show her spouse, Andrew Twinem, and their children: Margaret Alice, Mary Lou and Sarah Ann. a. ANN KINNEY [LC26-V72] showing spouse, John Hart, and their children: Albert Theodore, Jane and Margaret.

a. JOSEPH P. KINNEY [LHLX-FSQ] showing spouse, Sarah Ann Hart, and their children: Mary Alice, Robert Lee, Effa Jane, and Miles Emmet.

a. SARAH KINNEY [KNW2-JSZ] who never married

a. HENRY KINNEY [KPH2-P4S] showing spouse, Jane Davis, and their children: Catharine, Sarah Loretta and Frank.

\*\*3. Nathan used the very top half of the tree, on page 206, for the family of the son of Thomas and Margaret: , HENRY KINNEY [AFN LCJX-F3X] who was married twice, wives: Margaret Evans and Ruth Russell. His group really fill out the top part of the tree!

\*\*\*3b. CHILDREN: : Along the branches connected to Henry and his first wife, Margaret:

b. Anna Kinney [L716-2HY] showing spouse: John Lisle; and their children: Margaret, Sarah, William, Henry, Charles, Joel, George, Viola, James, Joseph, and Emmet.

b. JOEL KINNEY [LZ7S-B8H] showing two spouses. First wife, listed as Martha Milliner, and their two children, Mary Elizabeth and Martha Flora. Joel's second wife, Martha Kemp, and their children: Sarah Margaret, Henry Jenkinson and Ruth Ann.

b. GEORGE KINNEY [LCVS-S52] and his wife, Lydia Ann Russell. The tree only names the child, Alonzo, but has drawn in seven "nameless" leaves for this family.

b. LYDIA ANN KINNEY [KF2W-81F] showing spouse, Hartley Phillips, and their children: Nimrod, Mary, Chatham, Tamson, Russell and Gregg Phillips.

b. SARAH ELIZABETH KINNEY [26VQ-W3B] and her spouse, Isaiah Lamp. No names of children are listed, but there are five "nameless" leaves drawn for their family.

HENRY KINNEY's first wife died and he then married Ruth Russell. And so, Nathan Kinney listed their children as well in his diagram. They are:

b. THOMAS RUSSELL KINNEY [LCVS-32L] who was married twice. His first spouse is not listed. The second wife is "Lee Mitchell"

b. MARGARET KINNEY [97Z8-KTZ] nothing further for her.

b. EMILY MATILDA KINNEY [LWFK-Y7D] and her spouse, William Perkins

b. MARY AMANDA KINNEY [KNDX-RGP]

b. SAMUEL CHAMBERS KINNEY [KGM1-2FK] and wife, Sevilla Perkins

b. ARMINDA KINNEY [97Z8-KTV] who did not marry

\*\*4. Now going back to page 207, starting at the bottom of the tree and the main branches along the right side, the lowest branch is for JAMES KIN-NEY [AFN: KCDT-RVW] who married Mary Milleson. This couple had at least eight children. \*\*5. Still following along the right side of the tree and still on page 207, the next highest branch is for JOHN KINNEY [AFN: 9WX7-W32] who married twice, wives: Mary Erwin and Mary Emerson. Following that family around the page is gonna be WORK!

\*\*6. Now we move on to page 206, once again, to follow the next higher branch which is for the daughter, DEBORAH KINNEY [AFN: KHZ4-1TL] She did not marry, but did produce an illegitimate son, William, who had several children. Zoom in on Deborah

\*\*7. The last large branch off the trunk of this tree is for daughter, JANE KINNEY [AFN: LWJR-RF2], who married John Evans. Having 11-12 children:

\*\*\*7f. CHILDREN: Along the branches connected to Jane and John Evans:

f. Elisha Evans, who married Mary Jane Emerson; Their children: William, Melissa, John and Mary Louise Evans. [note: Nathan made empty "marks" for 3-5 more children].

f. Mary Evans, who married Joseph Lisle. and their children: John, James, Mary P, Charles Albert, Emma, Jane, Sarah, Hugh, Thomas, and Isaac Evans.

f. Lee Evans, who married Martha Shipman; Their children: Hannah, Melvina, Ruth, Adah Evans.

f. Margaret Evans, who married Jacob Wilcox; and their children: Jane and Emma Wilcox.

f. Deborah Evans, who married James Berry. and their children: Lewis, Martha, Nathan, Melissa, John, Mary Jane and Edgar Berry.

f. Ruth Evans, who married J. D. Mays; Their son Thomas E.

f. Eden Evans, who married twice. First wife: Teresa

Dowdell; her children: Nora, Annie and Ida Evans. His Second wife: Celia Perkins had one child: Loa Evans.

f. Elwood Evans, who married Celia Pryor. Their children: Watson, and Lucetta Delphine Evans.

f. Sarah Elizabeth Evans, who married John Battin. [Here Nathan has three "marks" for children, but no names listed.

f. William Henry Evans, his wife's name is illegible but might say "storsleult"?
